## **Great Harbour Trawlers Adds New N47 To Their Charter Fleet**

**Gainesville, FL – November 15, 2008** An all new Great Harbour N47 is being added to the company's charter fleet which operates in the Abacos in the Northern Bahamas during early Spring through mid Summer. The new N47 will head to Marsh Harbour in February where it will join the company's fleet of Great Harbour N37s after appearing in the Miami International Boat Show.

The brand new 2009 flying bridge model named "The Busted Flush" features three full-size staterooms, two heads and crew quarters. It is an ideal size for two families and their children or three couples and is available as a bareboat, captained or fully crewed charter.

Like all Great Harbour Trawlers, "The Busted Flush" offers all the comforts of home. Her spacious galley is equipped with full-size home appliances, and the main saloon has seating for 10 with additional sleeping accommodations for 4. Set up for island hopping in style, she features a 3-zone air conditioning system, generator, washer and dryer, gas grille and flat-screen TV with surround sound. Her flying bridge has seating

for 12, a dinette area for 6 and a helm equipped with a glass bridge electronics system. A large swim platform with boarding ladder, outdoor hot and cold shower, snorkeling gear and RIB inflatable with a 4-stroke outboard will be appreciated by water sports and beachcombing enthusiasts.

The Great Harbour N47 is the perfect boat for cruising the Bahamas, as its draft is only 3-feet, allowing it to enter some of the most beautiful anchorages in the Island chain. Powered by fuel-efficient, twin diesel engines and equipped with a powerful bow thruster, the N47 is easy to maneuver even for the novice skipper.

Charters will be available for lengths of one week or longer, typically Sunday to Saturday and originating in Marsh Harbour. Bareboat charters will enjoy being able to explore from Treasure Cay in the north down to Little Harbour in the south. Captained and fully crewed charters are limited in range only by time.

Price for a bareboat charter is \$7,200 per week, including fuel. Captained charters cost \$9,200 per week. Fully-crewed charters start at \$16,900 per week for 6 guests including all meals and beverages with a standard bar. An extra large, fast tender is included with a fully crewed charter, and the captain and crew stay in crew quarters.

### **Learn While On Vacation**

For those beginners who would like to learn to operate their own trawler, chartering the N47 with a captain is an ideal option. At no extra cost, Great Harbour's captain will teach the basics of trawler operation and navigation to those interested in learning. This is a terrific way to find out if the trawler lifestyle is for you and to give you the confidence to do a bareboat charter in the future.
